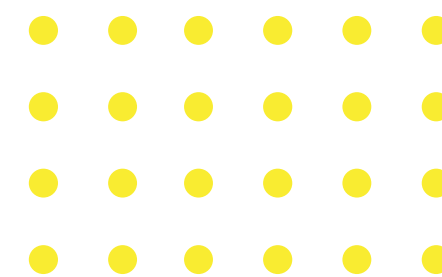

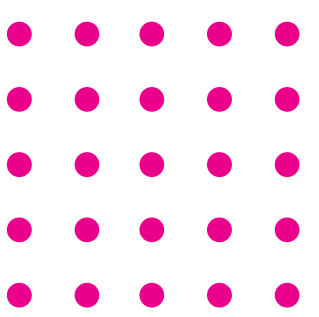

Support different work modes with a variety of space types, from focus areas to collaboration hubs.

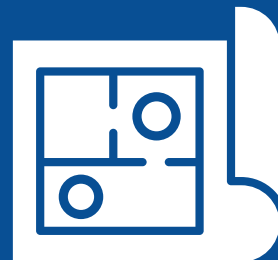


## Review and refine regularly

Continuously monitor and adjust based on data and employee feedback.

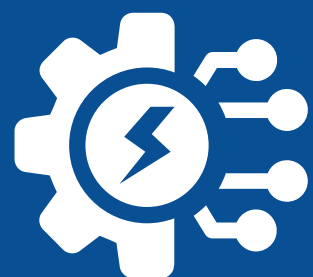

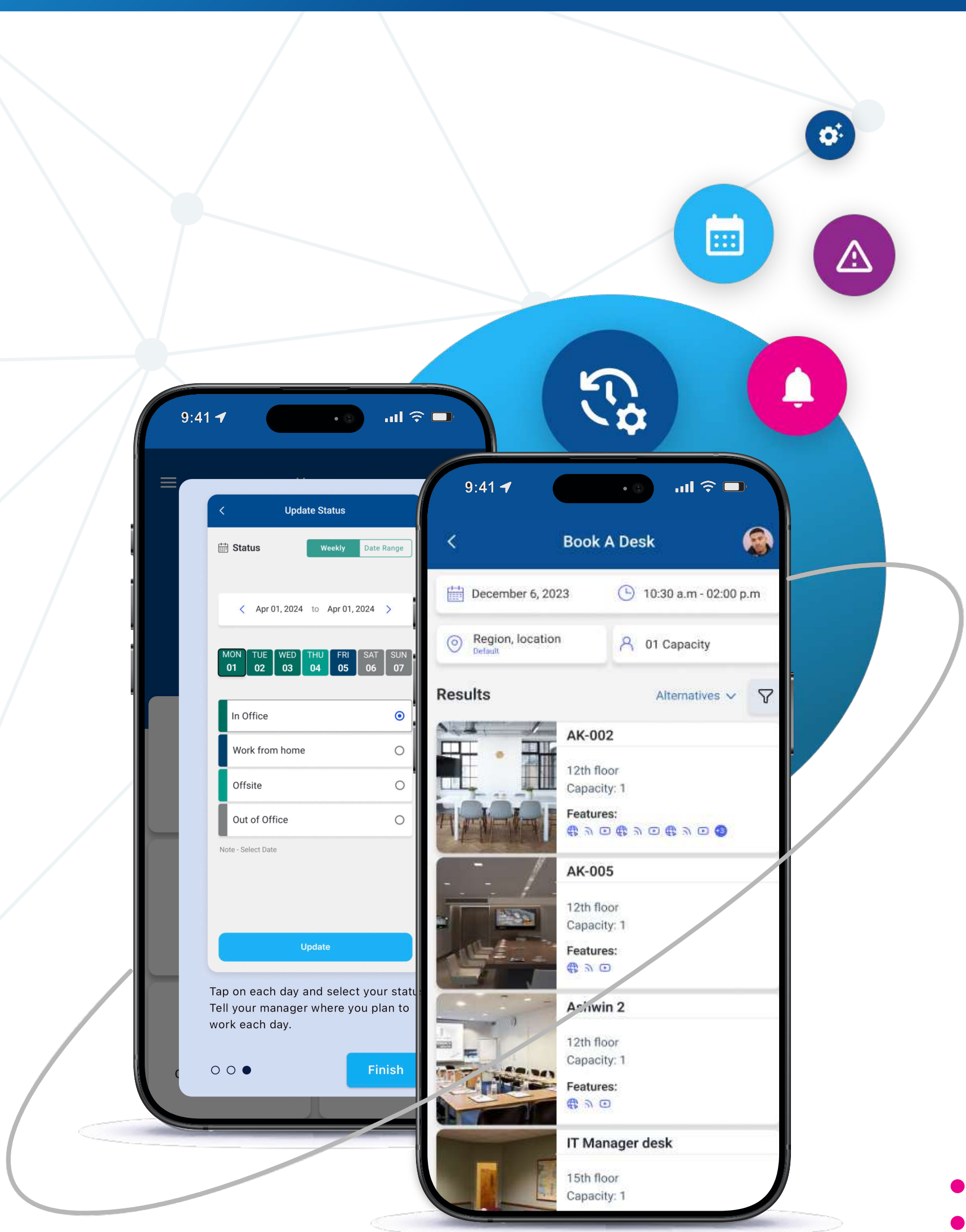


## Automatic Energy Savings

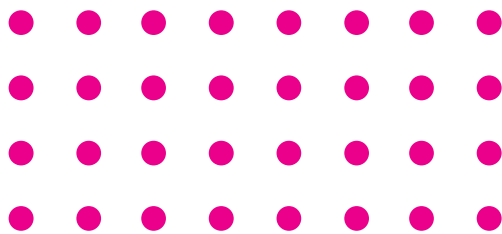

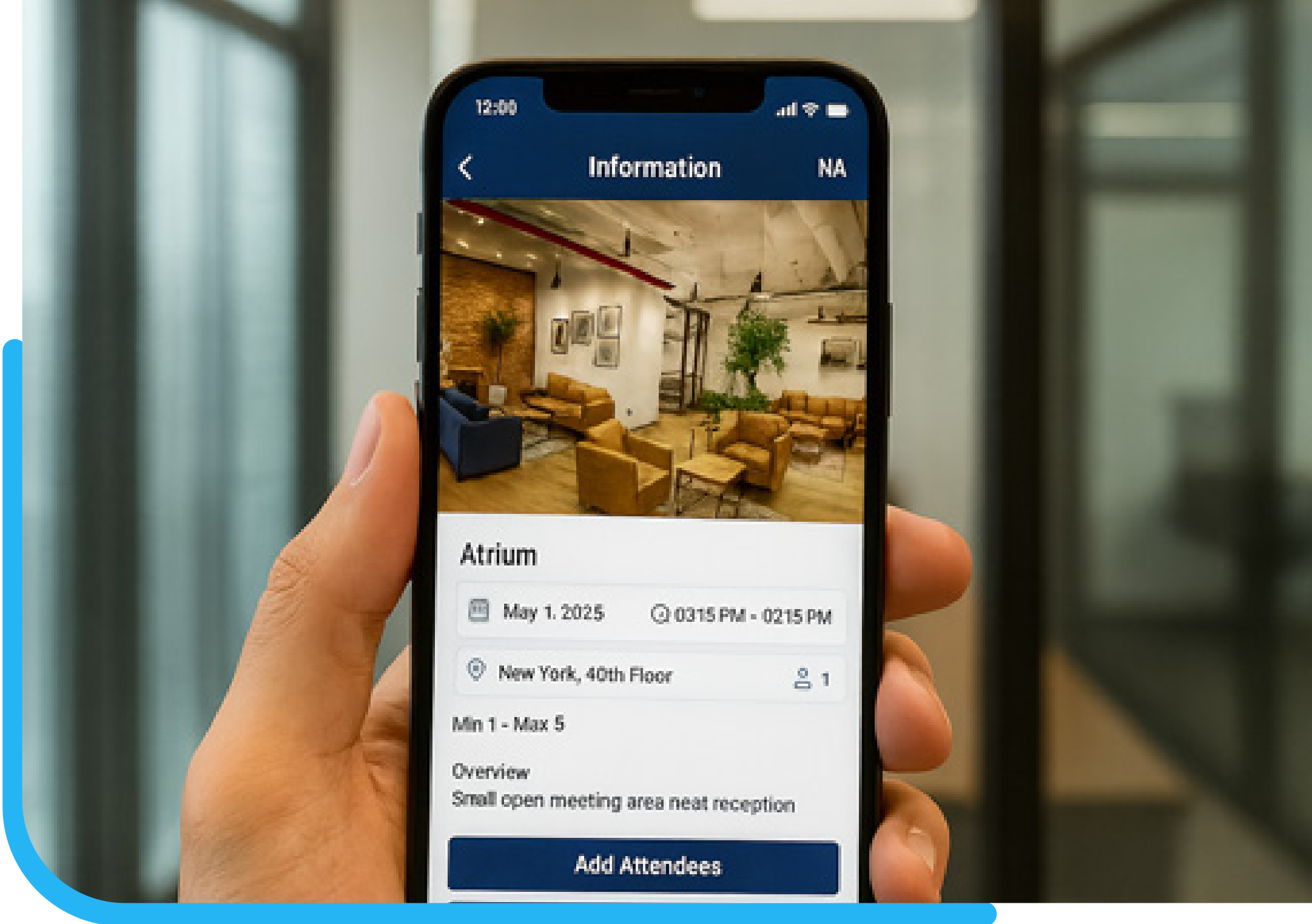

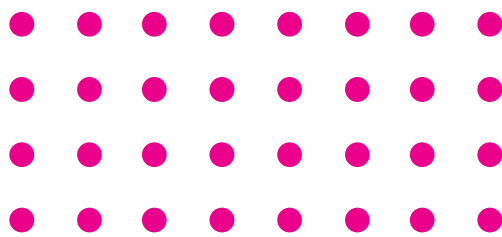
